

Instruction for CITI Training:

- Select "**Register.**"
- "Select Your Organization Affiliation," by searching for organization, "**University of North Texas Health Science Center.**"
- Provide your information for setting up a unique username and password.
- After registering, you will be presented with a series of questions or options to enable you to enroll in the **Learner Group** appropriate to your interests or your role in Lab Animal Welfare.
- We require completion of the following modules:
 - "Working with the IACUC"
 - Minimizing Pain and Distress
 - Post Approval Monitoring (PAM)
 - "Species Specific Training" based on the species used (ask your mentor if needed).
- There are other modules that may need to be completed as well, based on what you will be doing in the project (i.e., Antibody Production, Aseptic Surgery).

Instructions for Completing Coursework:

- Complete the Integrity Assurance Statement presented at the top after clicking a course title. The system will allow you to start taking the course modules after completing it.
- Complete the Required modules and associated quizzes.
- Complete the required number of Elective modules and associated quizzes
- When you complete all Required Modules in your curriculum and any necessary Elective **Previously Completed**
 - The **Basic Course** for the Lab Animal Welfare **Core Courses** will be graded **A** or **B** depending on the curriculum prescribed by your organization. **Core for the** running tally is compiled in the Grade Book.
